This hardback full colour book comes recommended for children from 3 to 7 years, but people of all ages who like puzzles and mazes and are fans of “Where's Wally?” style books will be intrigued. A real time-filler for those wet days at home or on holiday.

Last year Myles Lawford published his book *Where's Kiwi?* which took children round the major tourist spots in New Zealand, searching his illustrations for Kiwi and friends.

In this second book Kiwi, Sporty Sheep, Gumboot Guy, Wacky Wizard, and Tricky Tuatara travel the major centres of the world, crossing continents and oceans. From Sydney to Paris, Beijing to Hollywood, they see the sights, have a lot of fun, and experience some of the different cultures of the world:
